The Sneham Charitable and educational trust is the sum total of the work of a group of youngsters who gathered with the aim of doing possible virtue to the society keeping within the limited situations.

Death of a friend, the veins which had turned black due to radiation to pure blood cancer. The days we spend in the cancer center at Adayar. The efforts to leave life for death. The scenes of life witnessed by us and scenes which we tried to see after those days were different. After it what happened was a race for them who have been suffering from sickness. An effort to those who suffer due to sickness.

The complete time of our communion became the time for the poor like this. It is from this view that effort to get a form of a trust. Since its beginning in 2013 it has always been lively on a 24x7 basis. These activities got started at Muvattupuzha. The trust coordinated these activities in the first stage by giving food to the wanderers on stages. When we went in search of beggars who wander on streets, handicapped, pickers of waste, the helpless lottery sellers and the old people got much reception which was beyond expectation. Every day the number of people waiting for us on our way increased. We could supply hundreds of food packets daily though we started with 20-30 food packets. Majority of the people who had come to get the food packets were of shabby dress. Our next effort was to make the shabby dress people gentle men after making them dressed neatly. We gave them good and unused dress from our houses after collecting them. We crossed the second step of the union of love.

From our frequent contact with the wanderers on street, we could learn that many of them had epidemics and chronic diseases. We could make many of them enter protection/ Shelter homes using the health treatment facilities of the Govt. with the help of volunteers. We could easily make many of them enter protection-shelter homes using the health treatment facilities of government with the help of volunteers. We could easily make the medicine available and to provide hospital equipment to certain others. There





are so many people who helped us for these activities. all these peoples came to us and witnessing our activities on streets.

Let me Explain our activities

NANMA 2013

it is a great thing to find virtue even in small things. each virtue and happiness occurring in our life are to be shared with others too. The name given by Sneham Charitable and Education Trust to coordinate its many activities is NAMA. The activities in 2013 got started with the prayer that let each year be virtuous. NANMA 2013 was a different idea.

This is not a special programme. It is an intense desire that some kind of virtue should happen through the activities of Sneham in the lives of many people who suffer in society. One autorickshaw driver, Binu, who had observed our activities from the outside, took us to the General Hospital, Muvattupuzha, asking us to serve the patients in the pain and palliative care unit. Our journey in the coming days was in his vehicle. He took us to hard scenes where there were people having no daily bread and who could not change their dress without the help of others. Each hour and story were experiences for us.

It is by coordinating the palliative care activities in the General Hospital, Muvattupuzha, that Sneham Charitable and Education Trust got a new direction. We got the conviction that in society there are people who seek us and how helpless they are for our help. The field of operation of the General Hospital is the total area including the Muvattupuzha municipality and the adjacent 10 panchayath. We visited the houses continuously in all these areas. Though the duty time of the "Home Care" of the employees in the palliative care was over. We supplied essential equipment to the houses of the poor patients in our vehicles.

We could extend help directly to all most 300 houses within six months. We extended the help to hundreds of houses by way of social media. These were the activities

for the last year to tell in a nutshell

1. Food for one time for all
2. Palliative care- Volunteer work
3. Food kits to all families
4. Supplied medicine and medical equipment to deserving peoples
5. provided treatment and medicine to the wanters on steet and rehabilitated them to shulter
